Type "East Ridge Library" where it says "Find someone's Wish List"

Click on "Go"

Order a book (or two!) and bring it in to the library.

Note: You can also have the book sent directly to the East Ridge Library. If you do this, when ordering, check the "Ordering a gift" checkbox. Later there will be a box, "Enter your free gift note here" where you can type the name of your child so that we know who the book is from.

## Your child will be recognized

Your child will then be recognized during his/her library time. We will place a Friends of the Library bookplate with your child's name and school year in the book. Your child will receive a bookmark and be the first to check out the book. In addition, your child's name and book donated will be posted in the library and school newsletter (first initial and last name).
