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**High School Musical Jr. BEHAVIOR CONTRACT**

In order for High School Musical Jr. to succeed, participants need to want to participate and agree to abide by the following rules:

I therefore agree:

1. I want to participate in High School Musical Jr.
2. I will be respectful of the show directors, student volunteers, and parent volunteers
3. I will show consideration for others by using an appropriate voice level and by listening and using respectful language and gestures.
4. I will show pride in our school by keeping the school grounds, library and classrooms free of litter and taking good care of the building.
5. I will protect and care for the props, costumes and sets.
6. I will not touch or disturb anything in the donated gym, stage and music spaces.
7. I will build others "up" and not "down". I will not use put downs, gossip or exclude others.
8. I will eat all snacks in the outside under cover area of the school. I will not eat snacks in any foyers, the gym, stage, or library.

If I disregard one of the above rules, I know the following steps will be taken:

1. I will be asked to not engage in the inappropriate behavior and my name will be placed on a list in the gym by a parent or student volunteer in order to not disturb the cast and director.
2. If my name is placed on the list twice in one day, I will be asked to leave rehearsal and not interact with others for a temporary period of time.
3. If my name is place on the list three times in one day, I will lose the privilege of participating in rehearsal for the remainder of that day. Someone will be contacted to pick me up from school or I will wait quietly until I am picked up at the end of rehearsal.
4. Should I lose the privilege of full participation two times (see number 3), I will not be invited back to the PTA play for any remaining rehearsals. In this case, no money will be refunded.

## High School Musical Jr. Technical Crew / Creative Sound Design

Grades 5 & 6,  
12 students maximum

- Mandatory HSM tech rehearsals: 3/5, 3/6, 3/7 and 3/8 from 3:15-6:00 pm in the East Ridge Gym.
- HSM shows: Friday, March 9th, 7:00pm and Saturday, March 10th, 2:00pm & 7:00pm (expect to be called 2 hours before each show)
- Tear down: Saturday March 10<sup>th</sup> following the 7pm show (parent help needed for this too!)

A giant cherry is perched on a mountain and a group of animals - 2 chickens, 4 squirrels and a goat to be exact - are climbing, exhausted, to the top.
